Pregnancy / Delivery

■ Issuance of Maternal and Child Health Handbook

Those who are pregnant should report to the Health Promotion Section with a certificate of pregnancy, a personal identification number (My Number Card or notification card), and a form of personal identification. Your Maternal and Child Health Handbook will be issued. This handbook is designed to protect the health of mothers and children. Please use it as a record of your health at the time of medical checkups and vaccinations.

■ Issuance of health check ups form for pregnant women and infants

The Maternal and Child Health Checkup Voucher Booklet is issued at the same time as the Maternal and Child Health Handbook. The Maternal and Child Health Checkup Voucher Booklet includes a medical examination form that allows expectant and nursing mothers and infants to receive general health examinations free of charge. In addition, a portion of the examination fee will be subsidized for those who receive the examination outside of the prefecture. For details, please contact the Health Promotion Section.

■ Class for expecting mothers and fathers

This is a class for expectant mothers and their families to learn about the mother's and baby's physical condition, diet, and postpartum life.

■ Dispatch of postpartum relief helpers

Helpers are dispatched to mothers who have difficulty with childcare or housework due to poor health or other reasons. (fee required)

■ Postpartum care and education

Care for mother and baby, lactation counseling, childcare support, etc. are available at medical institutions and midwifery homes. (fee required)

■ Medical expense subsidy for pregnancy-induced hypertension

Medical expenses are partially subsidized for pregnant women who need to be hospitalized for 7 days or more due to pregnancy-induced hypertension. (Income restrictions apply.)

■ **Support for children's vaccinations**

Eligible vaccinations: Mumps, Influenza, Rotas (for children born before July 31, 2020), and Hepatitis A. Voluntary vaccinations for children who are not off the routine immunization age.

Amount: Maximum 1,000 yen per vaccination (up to one vaccination per fiscal year)

Eligible people: Citizens from age 0 to 3rd year of junior high school

Application period: Within 1 year from the month following the date of vaccination

■ Temporary care (at all Child Care Support Centers)

Temporary child care (fee required) for healthy infants who are not enrolled in nursery schools, children's schools or kindergartens who live in the city from 3 months after birth to preschool is available. Reasons for bringing children to temporary care include child care not being available at home due to parents' illness, parents' requiring a break, intermittent employment, etc.

■ Care for children after illness (Child Care Support Center Sugahara, Awada kodomo-en, Arisu kodomo-en)

For infants living in the city from 3 months after birth to preschool, who cannot go to a nursery school / children's center after illness, or if you cannot take care of your family due to illness or employment of a guardian, we will temporarily care for infants and toddlers after illness.

*Fee required for infants who are not enrolled in a nursery school / certified kindergarten.

■ Sick child care (conducted at Pony Posh) (Yokomiya-machi 16-9, (076) 248-7780)

If parents are sick or have trouble with home care due to employment, we will temporarily take care of sick children from birth to elementary school age. (fee required).

■ Application / Inquiry

Please make a reservation at each facility for temporary childcare and childcare for sick and post-illness children and complete the application procedure. When applying, please bring your hanko stamp, your child's insurance card, and your doctor's certificate (only for sick and post-illness children). If there is a charge, please pay the childcare fee on the day of care.

Admission to Elementary and Junior High School

The Board of Education will send a notice of school enrollment by the end of January on the year of enrollment to the homes of children and students enrolled in elementary and junior high schools.

Please contact the School Education Section of the Board of Education, in any of the following cases:

1. If you do not receive a notice of school enrollment.
2. If you are moving to a new residence or if you move out of the area after receiving a notice of school enrollment.
3. If the child is entering a school other than a municipal elementary or junior high school (such as a private school or prefectural school).
4. If the child is unable to attend school for unavoidable reasons such as illness or mental/physical disability.
5. If any of the content in the school enrollment notice is not accurate.

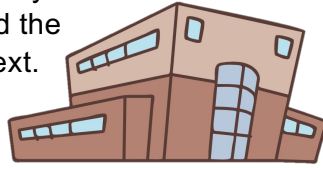

Procedure for Transferring Schools

Please contact the school you have been attending and the school you will attend next.



Complete move-in or move-out or change of address procedures at the Residents Section.

Due to special circumstances, if the student wants to continue attending the school they were attending, please contact the School Education Section.

- If you are moving in / moving (change of school district), submit the notification regarding school transfer (addressed to the principal) received from the Residents Section to the next school, together with the documents received at the previous school.
- If you are moving out, please go through the move-in procedures at the new municipality and submit the documents received at the school you were enrolled into the next school.

Consultations

■ Consultation about entering school

Please consult with us for children who are going into elementary and junior high school and may need special consideration for education due to the following:

- Hard of hearing
- Pronunciation is unclear
- Extremely poor eyesight
- Difficulty in basic body movements
- Delays in language development
- Difficulty communicating with others
- Special medical needs or living regulations
- Children who are currently attending elementary and junior high school and need to enroll in special needs classes

■ Educational counseling for parents/children

At the education center, we give consultations to parents and children who need help working through problems. (Closed on Saturdays, Sundays, national holidays, and year-end and New Year holidays)

School Aid

Education Administration Section (076) 227-6113

For parents whose children are enrolled in elementary or junior high schools in Nonoichi City and who have difficulty in enrolling their children in school due to financial reasons, the city provides partial assistance for school expenses such as school supplies and school lunches. (income restrictions may apply)

Child Welfare

■ Children's Allowance

Provided to those who are raising children until the end of junior high school.

■ Child-rearing Allowance

Paid to mothers, fathers, and caregivers who are raising children up to 18 years old (under 20 years old if they have a disability) who do not live with their father or mother due to divorce of their parents or other reasons. (income restrictions apply)

■ Medical expenses subsidies for single-parent families

We will subsidize medical expenses (covered under health insurance) exceeding 1,000 yen for per month for parents and children of single-parent families and children without parents. This is for children up to 18 years old (under 20 years old if they have a disability). There are income restrictions. If additional benefits or high-cost medical expenses are paid from the health insurance, the amount will be deducted.

■ Mother/Father and child widows welfare fund loan

The city provides loans at low or no interest to stabilize and improve the lives of single-parent families and widows. Mother-child / father-child independence support staff will conduct interviews.

■ Registration of My Nursery

By registering a nursery school / child institution in the city and the child-care support center Sugahara as "My Nursery School", you are free to attend child-rearing classes, childcare consultation services, and temporary childcare. These services are intended for pregnant women and parents of preschoolers under 3 years old.

■ Child-rearing Support Medical Expense Subsidy

The city will subsidize medical expenses (covered under health insurance) incurred from birth to the end of the 18th year, which exceeds 1,000 yen per month. If additional benefits or high-cost medical expenses are paid from the health insurance, the amount will be deducted.

■ Premature baby care

Provided to infants born prematurely (babies with a birth weight of 2,000 g or less or whose vitality is particularly weak) and who require hospitalization at a designated medical institution.

■ Special child-rearing allowance

Paid to those who are raising children with disabilities (income restriction apply)

■ Independence support medical care (Nurturing Medical Care)

We subsidize medical expenses for children under 18 years old with physical disabilities for medical care to eliminate or treat the disabilities.

■ Health Funds for Orphans

A lump sum payment will be provided to dependents of orphans who have lost their father or mother due to an accident and have not yet completed compulsory education. Mother-child / father-child independence support staff will facilitate the procedures.

■ Family Support Center

This organization introduces people who want to help (members offering help) to those who want help with raising children (members requesting help).

Aid Activities:

- Take care of children before and after childcare facility operating hours.
- Taking children to childcare facilities.
- Take care of children in case of parent's illness, long-term care, urgent need, etc.
- Take care of children on daycare facility holidays.
- Take care of children when parent need to go shopping, etc.
- Take care of children while recovering from illness.

Usage Fee: 700 yen per hour

■ Snow Removal Subsidy Project

The city will subsidize the cost of snow removal for mother and child households exempt from municipal tax.

■ Higher Vocational Training Promotion Benefit System

People who receive a child-rearing allowance or have a similar income may receive subsidy if they are training at training institution for more than one year. The training has to be related to qualifications such as a nurse, certified care worker, childcare worker, physical therapist, or work-care lawyer. Prior consultation with a mother-child / father-child independence supporter is required.

■ Independence Support Education and Training Benefit System

People who receive a child-rearing allowance or have a similar income level take an education and training course deemed necessary for employment or career advancement can have 60% of those expenses subsidized (upper limits apply). Prior consultation with a mother-child / father-child independence supporter is required.

■ Pediatric Chronic Specific Diseases

Ishikawa Central Health and Welfare Center subsidizes medical expenses for people with specific chronic pediatric diseases who meet the certification criteria.
